



## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR BTRC** **MEMBERS ONLY SHOWS 2020**

You are required to read these terms and conditions IN FULL as a condition of entry. Your entry to take part in Bucklow Trafford Riding Club competitions is an acknowledgement and agreement with these T's & C's.

You are aware that there is currently a global pandemic of COVID-19, and as such, there are risks associated with partaking in equestrian activity. The organisers have taken steps to try and ensure the safety of competitors, and cannot accept responsibility for any subsequent illness or injury. Anyone found not to be complying with these rules will no longer be welcome at Bucklow Trafford Riding Club.

By entering, you are consenting to us sharing your entered details (name, address, telephone number) with relevant authorities for Tracking and Tracing purposes, should there be a risk of infection identified. This is in line with Government guidelines.

These terms and conditions have been developed from BRC, British Horse Society, UK Sport Council and HM Government guidelines.

YOU MUST NOT ATTEND IF YOU OR A MEMBER OF YOUR HOUSEHOLD/ SUPPORT BUBBLE HAVE DEVELOPED ANY SIGNS OR SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19. These include: high temperature or fever; a new continuous cough; loss or change in sense of smell or taste; shortness of breath. You must also NOT attend if you have been contacted by a tracing service and advised that you should self-isolate. Entry transfer is available for this purpose.

We strongly advise those who are in the "extremely high risk" medical category, or those who are shielding, not to attend - but recognise this is your own personal choice.

ALL entries must be done via email, forms are available on the website. No entries will be accepted in any other format and you must be a member of the club for 2020.

We advise the use of face masks or coverings when not riding.

You MUST maintain an appropriate social distance in line with government guidelines at ALL TIMES when on the grounds. Please pay attention to signage and walkways.

Please attend the competition alone, or with ONE other member of your household or support bubble. Please do not bring extra spectators. We ask grooms where

possible to stay with horse boxes and trailers and only stand at the ringside if your rider / handler is in the ring and it is necessary. Please ensure you have hand sanitiser available in your grooming kits for your own use.

There will be a limited number of horses / ponies allowed in the warm up arena at any one time, once the previous class to yours has entered the ring you will be permitted to use the warm up area and not before.

Warm up time is limited to 20 minutes only per competitor. We ask competitors not to arrive more than 60 minutes to approximate schedule of class times. Members who are stabled on Dairyhouse Farm we ask where possible you use arenas on your yard to warm up just to try and reduce numbers on the show ground.

Competitors competing in the in-hand ring are asked to remain close to their transport, until your class is called forward.

The Booking Office will be open for paperwork for Judges / Stewards / Committee members but OUT OF BOUNDS for all members and queries. If you have any problems on the day and need to speak to an organiser, please call 07973 539554 or email after the show any queries that can be dealt with later.

We strongly advise AGAINST using the show ground toilet facilities this is solely for the use of judges / stewards and show working committee. We ask you to use your own toilet in horse boxes and trailers, and those from Dairyhouse farm use your own facilities in your own bubble. NO OTHER FACILITIES WILL BE AVAILABLE. Please be aware of this possible eventuality.

We will have several hand sanitisation stations available around the warm up and food area. Please use them regularly - we also encourage you to bring your own. Please note we have no facilities for hot handwashing with soap and water.

Competitors will be lined up in order of placings once judging completed and the steward will note down results, but rosettes will not be handed out, once all competitors have left the ring the steward will place rosettes on ring ropes for grooms / riders to collect promptly. Stewards have hand sanitiser available to them in rosette boxes which they will use regular.

After completion of all your classes please leave the show ground promptly, taking any rubbish with you.

Thank you for your cooperation in this matter and keeping everyone safe. Also thank you for supporting BTRC and attending our show. We hope you have a great day.
